

HVAC2-144: Servicing and Troubleshooting Refrigeration and Air Conditioning

Minimum Qualifications: 2 years industry experience verifiable through employment history and EPA Type II or EPA Universal 608.

A performance exam would be administered by one of the HVAC/R department faculty in the HVAC/R Department of the Oak Creek campus during the instructor's normally scheduled on campus time. A study guide would be provided one week in advance of the exams if the applicant chooses to request one. The student will have 2 hours to complete the written examination and 2 hours for the practical portion. The written exam portion will cost an additional \$20 beyond any other charges associated with the CPLE process.

Student taking written exam must complete at or above 80% for consideration. This would be considered a "one time" application process. Minimum qualifications must be demonstrated in the first attempt.
