Under state statutes and the MATC District Plan of Representation, a "School District Administrator" is defined as the school district superintendent, supervising principal or other person who acts as the administrative head of a school district located in the MATC District.

An "Employer Member" is defined as any person who receives earnings as payment for personal services and possesses the power to hire, transfer, suspend, layoff, recall, promote, discharge, assign, reward, or discipline other employees, or adjust employee grievances, or effectively recommend such action, if in connection with the exercise of such power the person exercises independent judgment in relation to the power. Employer does not include a person acting in the capacity of officer or agent of a labor organization.

An "Employee Member" is defined as any person who is not an employer and who receives earnings as payment for personal services, and includes a person acting in the capacity of officer or agent of a labor organization

A public hearing and meeting of the Appointment Committee is scheduled for 9:00 a.m. on Saturday, March 21, 2009, at Milwaukee Area Technical College, Room M616, 1015 North 6th Street. Enclosed please find a legal notice outlining the procedures that must be followed in applying for MATC District Board membership. BOARD MEMBER POSITION VACANCIES

Applications for three positions on the Milwaukee Area Technical College (MATC) District Board are now being accepted. Applicants must be residents of the District.

The following District Board Member categories have vacancies:

One School District Administrator – three-year term expiring June 30, 2012

One Employer Member – three-year term expiring June 30, 2012

One Employee Member – three-year term expiring June 30, 2012

Under state statutes and the MATC District Plan of Representation, a “School District Administrator” is defined as the school district superintendent, supervising principal or other person who acts as the administrative head of a school district located in the MATC District.

An “Employer Member” is defined as any person who receives earnings as payment for personal services and possesses the power to hire, transfer, suspend, layoff, recall, promote, discharge, assign, reward, or discipline other employees, or adjust employee grievances, or effectively recommend such action, if in connection with the exercise of such power the person exercises independent judgment in relation to the power. Employer does not include a person acting in the capacity of officer or agent of a labor organization.

An “Employee Member” is defined as any person who is not an employer and who receives earnings as payment for personal services, and includes a person acting in the capacity of officer or agent of a labor organization.

Board Members are not paid, except for expenses incurred in the performance of their duties.

In the appointment process, equal consideration is given to the general population distribution within the MATC District and the distribution of women and minorities. In addition, equal consideration is given to the distribution of minorities within the City of Milwaukee.

Applicants must complete and submit the required application form and submit at least two letters of reference supporting their nomination to the District Board, and attend a public hearing of the District Board Appointment Committee at which time they will be interviewed.
