Male nontraditional occupations (NTOs)

are careers that have 25% or less of the positions held by men. Examples include careers in nursing, dental and allied health services, early childhood education and fashion marketing.

MATC offers more than 45 academic programs that prepare students for careers designated as NTOs for men. See the listing on the back of this card.

Advantages for men choosing NTO careers:

- Greater career options and flexibility
- Opportunities for a more recession-proof, stable career track
- Increased job satisfaction
- Potential for faster career advancement

Prepare for your career at MATC

Associate degrees – Most are designed to be completed in two years of full-time study.

Technical diplomas – Most are designed to be completed in one year of full-time study.

Apprenticeship programs with local trade unions and/or business owners – Students enter apprenticeship programs through a selection process guided by employer needs.
