All USA Academic Team and Junior College Academic Team Fact Sheet and Time Line

Student Eligibility:

To be eligible for nomination, a student must be currently enrolled in an AACC member institution such as MATC and should expect to be enrolled at the same college through at least December 31, 2010. The nominee must have completed at least 36 college credits through December 2010 in pursuit of an Associate in Arts, Associate in Applied Arts, Associate in Science, or Associate in Applied Science degree prior to being nominated and must have a cumulative grade point average of 3.5 out of a possible 4.0 in all credit course work taken at the college. The nominee must also be on track to complete at least 48 college credits by August 30, 2011.

NOTE: Membership in the Phi Theta Kappa International Honor Society is not a requirement to apply for consideration, but is highly recommended.

College's Selection Procedures:

All interested students are required to submit and complete all sections of the Nominee Biographical Application Form B parts 1-9. The college's honor's committee will critique each finalist's application, essay and conduct interviews to determine the college's All-USA candidates. There is a maximum of 2 finalists per campus.

Applications submitted online by Monday, November 1, 2010

Applications reviewed and interviews conducted week of November 15-19, 2010

Nominees selected and applications forwarded to PTK by December 1, 2010 deadline

National Selection Procedure following the MATC competition:

A national team of independent judges will review all the college candidates and select a 20 member first team. Each will receive a \$2500 stipend, medallion and are featured in USA TODAY.
