



National Technical Honor Society MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION Fact Sheet

If you decide to apply for membership in the honor society, you must:

1. Complete the Membership Application online or download the form and either word process your responses on separate paper or type them using the form including the occupational major/program (select the most appropriate category — see NTHS Occupational Codes and Subgroups page for category breakdowns), occupational experience name/title*, description and supervisor's name. You will need to enter then name of the faculty nominator you have requested to complete the nomination form.
2. Sign and date the application in the Membership Authorization section
3. Provide your nominator with the attached Instructor Nomination form and "Nomination Procedures," which he or she is responsible for completing and submitting
4. Complete the Induction Ceremony Confirmation form only if you wish to be included in the current semester's induction, regardless of whether you are attending the ceremony or not.
5. Submit your membership application, and if applicable, induction confirmation form — indicating whether or not you will be attending the ceremony — to: curtinp@matc.edu or the Office of the Registrar (see address below) and the membership fee of \$35** (credit card or check or money order made payable to MATC).

* You must provide information about a work or volunteer experience within the last five years that is related to your current program of study. It may include clinical and internship experiences.

**** The fee represents a one-time payment. NOTE: If you are joining both honor societies, payment may be made with one check or money order.**
