WHEREAS, the Milwaukee Area Technical College District Board has entered into negotiations with Local 212, AFT, AFL-CIO (hereinafter "Local 212"); and

WHEREAS, the Board representatives have reached a tentative three-year agreement (February 16, 2011-February 15, 2014) with representatives of Local 212; and

WHEREAS, Local 212 (Part-time Faculty) has ratified the tentative labor agreement on February 16, 2011; and

WHEREAS, the Board has reviewed the terms and conditions of said agreement; therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Milwaukee Area Technical College District Board hereby accepts and approves the agreement reached by MATC and Local 212 (Part-time Faculty) bargaining unit, and authorizes signatures representing the MATC District Board and the Administration on the approved agreement, at which time said agreement shall be incorporated by reference to this resolution.

SUMMARY OF PROPOSED LABOR AGREEMENT
MATC & Local 212
(Full-time Faculty/Professionals; Paraprofessionals and Part-time Faculty)

All terms of the prior Labor Agreements remain in place except the following:

I. Wages

- a. Provide salary increase of : 0% July 1, 2011
0% July 1, 2012
2% July 1, 2013
- b. Total cost of proposal over 3 year contract = \$2,288,527

II. Healthcare Contributions

- a. Change to three-tier premium structure
- b. Healthcare contributions based on percent of pay
 - i. .8 of 1% of gross pay for single coverage
 - ii. 1.2% of gross pay for employee +1 coverage
 - iii. 1.5% of gross pay for family coverage
- c. MATC pay 60% of single plan for PT employees (up from 48% in previous contract)
- d. Increase retiree health insurance contributions for future retirees under age 65
- e. Total cost savings over 3 year contract = (\$1,174,728)*

III. Healthcare Plan Design Changes

- a. Wellness and biometric testing
- b. Network and plan design changes to increase deductibles, out of pockets and co-insurance for out-of-network services.
- c. 3-tier prescription plan with formulary list
- d. Total cost savings over 3 year contract = (\$6,644,102)*

IV. Frozen Positions

- a. Freeze 19 full-time Local 212 faculty positions through the term of the contract.
- b. No layoffs of full-time faculty and full-time paraprofessionals for the term of frozen positions.
- c. Total cost savings over 3 year contract = (\$6,098,136)

V. Term of Contract

- a. February 16, 2011 through February 15, 2014
- b. Total Cost Savings over 3 year contract = (\$11,628,439)

*Benefit savings include all groups except L587 employees.
