- Read, sign and date all applications.
- If you are 17 and under, have your parent or legal guardian sign all forms.
- Keep a copy of every document for your own records.
- Have a professional e-mail for school and financial aid purposes.

All information will be kept confidential and used only to determine your eligibility and admission to the program.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Be a first year student at MATC
- Be eligible to receive federal financial aid (FAFSA)
- Be a US citizen or US permanent resident

And additionally meet ONE of the following requirements:

1. Be from a seasonal or migrant background.
Either the student or his/her parent(s), or his/her immediate family must have worked at least 75 days in the past 24 months
2. Have participated in a Title I Part C, Migrant Education Program (MEP)
3. Have participated in a High School Equivalency Program (HEP) and graduated within the last 12 months
4. Have participated in Section 107, Workforce Investment Act Program (WIA 167)
