Summer Financial Aid Eligibility Requirements

You may be eligible for a Summer Federal Stafford Loan, Federal Pell Grant, Federal Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grant and/or Federal Work-Study if you meet all of the following requirements:

- You must have completed the 2008-09 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), which must be received by the U.S. Department of Education on or before June 30, 2009.
- For Federal Work-Study, you must also complete and submit a 2009-10 FAFSA.
- You must not owe a repayment of financial aid funds.
- You must not be in default on a Federal Student Loan.
- You must be admitted to a program and have a program code from the Admissions Office.
Attention Graduates: If you graduated, you must have an active program code in a financial aid eligible program for summer 2009 in order to be eligible to receive financial aid.
- You must meet the standards of academic progress and the 150% rule in order to receive financial aid for the summer. Your academic progress is based on the classes that you have completed and grades that you have earned through the Spring 2009 semester. Your current active program of study is used when calculating financial aid eligibility for 150%. This evaluation multiplies the total active program credits x 1.5 (150%) which gives us the maximum allowable credits that you are eligible to receive financial aid. If you have reached 150% you are not eligible to receive any more financial aid. If your Summer 2009 financial aid has been awarded and it is later determined that you did not meet the standards of academic progress or that you have reached 150% maximum, your financial aid for the summer will be cancelled. If you were awarded a student loan for the summer it will be cancelled and returned. You will be responsible for paying your course fees, books, and supplies for the classes that you are enrolled in for the summer.

150% Appeal Process: You may submit a 150% Appeal. You can print the 150% Appeal form by going to the following link: <http://www.matc.edu/student/resources/FinancialAid/finaid.html.doc>, and click on the 150% Rule Appeal Form. Follow the instructions as provided on the 150% Rule Appeal Form.

- **NOTE: You must be enrolled in at least 6 credits to receive a Federal Stafford Loan during the summer. If funds are available, students enrolled in less than 6 credit hours may be eligible to be awarded the Federal Pell Grant and/or Federal Supplemental Educational Opportunity Grant.
