

## **Wisconsin GI Bill Remission Request For Spring 2010**

Starting with the Spring 2010 term the State of Wisconsin has passed new eligibility rules and regulations for all WI GI Bill recipients. All students will need to submit a new WDVA 2029 form to our office.

Students who have received the WI GI Bill Remission in the past may not be eligible for the remission under the new regulations.

Please read the information provided on the Wisconsin Department of Veterans Affairs website thoroughly. The new form can also be printed from their website. Once you are at the website click into the WDVA B0105 link highlighted in pink. This is an information booklet called the Wisconsin Tuition Programs for Veterans, Qualifying Spouses and Children. You will find the WDVA 2029 on pages 12, 13 and 14 of this booklet.
