- Russ Denomie Scholarship Criminal Justice/Social Welfare (\$1000) dispersed at the Indian Summer Festival
- Kurt Klumb Business Scholarship (\$1000) dispersed at the Indian Summer Festival
- Circle of Art Scholarship, the Arts (\$500) dispersed in Spring semester
- George Amour Scholarship, 2 awards, \$500 each will be dispersed in the Spring semester
- Robert Peterman Scholarship (\$500) dispersed in the Spring semester
- Del Porter Scholarship (\$500) dispersed in the Spring semester

Eligibility:

1. American Indian-Must submit proof of tribal enrollment or descent. Descent is defined as having one or more ancestor(s) who is/(are) tribally enrolled.
2. Must be admitted to and attending an institution of higher education.
3. Must be a resident of the State of Wisconsin.
4. Preference given to applicants who have had service to the Indian Community.
5. Applicants who have previously received a scholarship are eligible to apply.
6. Must be a full time student to be eligible for the \$1000 scholarships and be enrolled half time or more to be eligible for the \$500 scholarships.

ONLY COMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL BE CONSIDERED.
