



## ALL-USA ACADEMIC TEAM

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### All-USA Community College Academic Team

#### Fact Sheet and Time Line

**Procedure** is established by Phi Theta Kappa Honor Society (PTK) who conducts the ALL-USA Academic Team process in conjunction with the American Association of Community Colleges (AACC) and various corporate sponsors.

**Process** involves an online application accompanied by letters of recommendation submitted through the Phi Theta Kappa Honor Society (PTK) website. It is not required to be a member of PTK in order to participate in the competition.

**Eligibility** includes current enrollment and completion of 36 associate degree credits, a 3.5 cumulative grade point average (**by December 1st**), and on-track to complete at least 48 college credits by **August 31st**.

**Timeline** for the application is approximately from the beginning of October through the beginning of December (via the PTK website). There is a maximum of 2 finalists per campus (for a total of eight possible nominees for the college).

**Verification** that applicants meet all eligibility requirements are confirmed upon review of the current academic record.

**Confirmation** due date established by PTK adheres to the due date specified by PTK which occurs prior to the end of MATC's Fall semester. **Applicant's academic record must reflect completion of all requirements on or before the confirmation due date established by PTK.**

**National Selection** procedure begins following the submittal of eligible applicants nation-wide; and reviewed by a national team of independent judges for selection.
