Pursue a career in child care or exceptional education settings for young children and have a positive impact on a child's life. Upon successful completion of this academy, students will earn the Child Care Services Technical Diploma and Preschool Certificate.

### **About**

Dual Enrollment Academy (DEA) participants receive college-level training to begin careers in high-demand fields. Throughout their senior year, DEA students earn high school and college credits while spending the majority of their school day at MATC. The DEA is designed for students attending high schools within MATC's district.

### **Student Eligibility Requirements**

- Be a 2026-27 high school senior
- Have a counselor recommendation
- · Have a high school GPA of 2.0 or higher
- Be in good academic standing and on track to graduate from high school
- Have 90% attendance record in high school (exceptions made for illness)

### Child Care Services Technical Diploma

Child development, nutrition, creative activities, and practical experience with young children are emphasized. Graduates work in child care centers, as well as serve as family child care providers. **EARNED IN DEA** 

### Early Childhood Education Associate Degree

Pursue a career in child care or exceptional education settings for young children and have a positive impact on a child's life. Program requirements include the completion of four practicum experiences. This degree transfers to all four year institutions for a degree in Early Childhood Education (i.e. kindergarten teacher).
