Animation Portfolio, ANIM-160, 2 credits
Work/Life Experience Portfolio

Credit for Prior Learning provides students a range of options to earn college credit for what they already know. Students can demonstrate college-level knowledge and competencies from examination, portfolio, to workforce and military.

1. **Course title, number & credit value:**
 - a. Animation Portfolio, ANIM-160, 2 credits
2. **Course description:**
 - a. Each student finalizes a series of 30-second to three-minute animated shorts demonstrating his/her capabilities. The collection is prepared for distribution to potential employers or to four-year animation degree programs. In addition, each student prepares a professional-level paperwork folio and a personal ID package (stationary, business cards, etc.), and is required to participate in the class preparation for the year-end departmental portfolio show in conjunction with other degree programs.
3. **Portfolio requirements that demonstrate competencies.** **Note for Resumes:* Lead faculty must verify the student's work history via a letterhead mail or phone interview.
 - a. Create an online portfolio of projects to be used in the interview process.
 - b. Create business cards for the interviewing process.
 - c. Create a professional resume to be used in the interview process.
