

Verification of Non-Filing Status

Individuals who did not file a federal tax return are still required to obtain verification of non-filing from the IRS. **However**, if an individual is unable to obtain a verification of non-filing letter from the IRS, they can provide a **signed statement** certifying that:

- They attempted to obtain a verification of non-filing letter from the IRS, but were unsuccessful; **and**
- They have not and are not required to file an income tax return for 2019.

If a non-filer had earnings from work, W-2s from each source of income must be provided.

Please use either non-filing statement with earnings from work (below) or non-filing statement with no earnings from work (next page). Only one statement should be completed.
