

Attention Early Childhood Educators: Use your experience to gain up to 18 credits toward your degree!

Learners with extensive credit, credentials, training and/or experience in early childhood education can earn up to 18 credits for prior learning and work experience to apply toward a Milwaukee Area Technical College associate degree or technical diploma program by **enrolling in the CHILDD-117 course**.

MATC Students:

- Go to selfservice.matc.edu.
- Choose Student Planning and Register.
- Enroll in CHILDD-117 course.

Non-MATC Students:

- Apply to MATC matc.edu/apply.
- · Choose the Early Childhood Education Associate of Applied Science or Childcare Services technical diploma.
- Once you're admitted, you can enroll in the CHILDD-117 course.

Learners will also receive guidance in developing a portfolio to earn credit for a maximum of four Early Childhood Education (ECE) courses (only one course may be a practicum) or 18 maximum credits.

Eligible students must have two years of full-time work experience in the early care and education field.
