



## Civilian Personal Safety & Protection Training

At Milwaukee Area Technical College, you will learn the design, function, care, maintenance and deployment of your Personal Defense Weapon. You will improve your tactical skills to understand the implications and legal responsibilities that come with ownership and carry privileges in the State of Wisconsin. MATC offers basic to advanced courses as well as specialty courses designed to hone one's ability to personally protect oneself and others.

### **Police 446 Basic Handgun Tactics (24 hours | 0.65 Credits)**

Comprehensive training to teach concealed carry methods, draw patterns, engagement and disengagement techniques, basic marksmanship skills, safe weapon handling, disassembly, cleaning, along with legal and ethical issues as related to Wisconsin CCW permit holders.

**Prerequisite:** None

### **Police 449 Advanced Handgun Tactics (18 hours | 0.5 Credits)**

A course designed to advance Wisconsin Permit holder's skills in low light tactics, barricade tactics, ground defense positions, malfunction and reloading drills, lateral and lineal movement and current legal topics affecting CCW permit holders.

**Prerequisite:** Police-446 – Must be completed prior to taking this course.

### **Police 425 Basic AR-15 Rifle Tactics (24 hours | 0.65 Credits)**

Designed to teach basic rifle nomenclature, care and cleaning, storage, safe handling skills, weapon carry positions, Phase I and II malfunction clears and the deliverance of precision fire on targets.

**Prerequisite:** None

### **Police 450 Advanced AR-15 Rifle Tactics (18 hours | 0.5 Credits)**

Advanced tactics designed to enhance a rifle operator's ability to clear weapon malfunctions, reload while moving, and deliver precision shot placement on target while safely handling a shoulder fired weapon.

**Prerequisite:** Police-425 – Must be completed prior to taking this course.

### **Police 445 Firearm Safety & Proficiency (45 hours | 1.25 Credits)**

Comprehensive course to reinforce firearms safety, care and cleaning, shooting fundamentals, weapons functioning, carry methods and legal issues. Individualized instructor tutoring with bi-weekly testing, culminating with competitive testing.

**Prerequisite:** Police-446 – Must be completed prior to taking this course
