1. Prerequisites

- **None**
- Criminal Background Check and Medical records and Drug Test will be required after acceptance

The Dental Assistant Program Petition **TWICE** a year: in **OCTOBER** for JANUARY start and in **MARCH** for AUGUST start.

The Petition Process is the method that students follow to inform the Healthcare Pathway when they are ready and prepared to begin the core technical courses in their chosen health science program. All students must petition and be accepted into their program before registering for core technical courses.
