
HEALTHCARE PROGRAM ADMISSION PROCESS



STEPS FOR ENROLLING

OPEN ENROLLMENT PROGRAMS

- 1. Contact a Healthcare Pathway advisor at healthpathway@matc.edu
- 2. Register for classes
- 3. Receive program orientation/CastleBranch information After the student registers for technical courses, the student will receive an email in their MATC Gmail account that will provide information about the program and next steps.





NURSING ASSISTANT PROGRAM

- 1. Complete the program admission checklist located at https://www.matc.edu/course-catalog/healthcare/documents/nursing-assistant-health-pack.pdf.
- 2. Prospective students must complete a criminal background check, drug screen and clinical requirements in CastleBranch.com prior to enrolling in the Nursing Assistant program. Students must place order in CastleBranch.com and use program code MF43.

- 4. After completing all the CastleBranch requirements, student must contact the Healthcare Pathway at healthpathway@matc.edu or 414-297-6088.

WAITLIST PROGRAMS

- 1. Complete the MATC application at matc.edu/apply.
- 2. Contact a Healthcare Pathway advisor at healthpathway@matc.edu.
- 3. Complete the program prerequisite course(s) and entrance exam by the specified review window time frames (for more testing information, please visit MATChealth.com).
- 4. Waitlist Review Process: Students are automatically on the waitlist based on their application to the college and then must meet the program's academic preparedness requirements. Students will receive an email to their MATC student email informing them if they were accepted or denied admittance into the program.
- 5. Student will receive email from the Admissions office that they must respond to.
- 6. Register for classes.
- 7. Attend the mandatory program orientation and follow next-step instructions.

OPEN ENROLLMENT PROGRAMS

Students can enroll in Open Enrollment Programs when enrollment begins each semester. The following programs do not require the student to go through the Waitlist process. Classes for these programs are available to students on a first-come, first-served basis.

Technical Diploma Programs

Dental Assistant (Bilingual-Spanish)

- Fall start: Registration for classes opens in April (this program only admits students one time a year)

Enhanced Yoga Instructor

- · No prerequisite courses
- Fall start: Registration for classes opens in April
- · Spring start: Registration for classes opens in November

Pharmacy Technician

- No prerequisite courses
- · Fall start: Registration for classes opens in April
- Spring start: Registration for classes opens in November

- · No prerequisite courses
- Fall start: Registration for classes opens in April
- Spring start: Registration for classes opens in **November**

WAITLIST PROGRAMS

Program qualification and selection criteria can be found on each program's webpage.

When there are more applicants than spots available in a program, MATC puts students on a waiting list. To get off the list as spots open up, students must meet and maintain all academic preparedness requirements specific to their program. Students are automatically on the waitlist based on their application to the college.

Associate Degree Programs

Minimum cumulative grade-point average required is 2.5 unless noted otherwise.

Anesthesia Technology

- TEAS entrance exam, minimum score 70% (3 lifetime attempts in person)
- C+ or higher: BIOSCI-177 or BIOSCI-201
- HEALTH-101
- Fall start: Review window in February (only one time a year)

Cardiovascular Technology-Echocardiography

- TEAS entrance exam, minimum score 70% (3 lifetime attempts in person)
- C+ or higher: BIOSCI-177
- June start: Review window in February (only one time a year)

Cardiovascular Technology-Invasive

- TEAS entrance exam, minimum score 70% (3 lifetime attempts in person)
- C+ or higher: BIOSCI-177
- **Spring start:** Review window in **September** (only one time a year)

Dental Hygiene

- TEAS entrance exam, minimum score 70% (3 lifetime attempts in person)
- B- or higher in the following courses:
 - BIOSCI-177 or BIOSCI-201 and 202
 - CHEM-186 or CHEM-207 and 208
 - BIOSCI-197
- · Fall start: Review window in February
- Spring start: Review window in September

Diagnostic Medical Sonographer

- TEAS entrance exam, minimum score 70% (3 lifetime attempts in person)
- B- or higher: BIOSCI-177 or BIOSCI-201
- BIOSCI-179 or BIOSCI-202
- PHYS-139 with a grade of C or higher
- June start: Review window in February (only one time a year)

Healthcare Services Management (HSM)

- C+ or higher in the following courses:
 - HEALTH-101
 - HEALTH-107
 - ENG-195 or ENG-201
- · Fall start: Review window in February
- Spring start: Review window in September



For Associate Degree and Technical Diploma Programs: The review period for Fall start programs is the month of **February** and for Spring start programs is the month of **September**.

Some programs require an entrance exam for admissions. Please go to <u>matchealth.com</u> for more information about examinations.

- C or higher in the following courses:
 - BIOSCI-189 or BIOSCI-177 or BIOSCI-201 and BIOSCI-202
 - C or higher: HEALTH-101 and HEALTH-107
- Fall start: Review window in February
- Spring start: Review window in September

LPN to ADN Progression

- HESI entrance exam minimum score required is 900 (3 lifetime attempts)
- · Current licensure in Practical Nursing
- B- or higher in the following courses:
 - BIOSCI-177 and 179 or BIOSCI-201 and BIOSCI-202
 - BIOSCI-197 (Sciences must be taken within last five years)
- Fall start: Review window in February
- · Spring start: Review window in September

Medical Laboratory Technician (MLT)

- TEAS entrance exam, minimum score 60% (3 lifetime attempts in person)
- B- or higher in the following courses:
 - BIOSCI-177 or BIOSCI-201 and BIOSCI-202
 - CHEM-186 or CHEM-207 and CHEM-208
 - BIOSCI-197
- Fall start: Review window in February
- Spring start: Review window in September

Occupational Therapy Assistant (OTA)

- TEAS entrance exam, minimum score 65% (3 lifetime attempts in person)
- B- or higher in the following courses:
 - BIOSCI-177 or BIOSCI-201 and BIOSCI-202
- Fall start: Review window in February (only one time a year)

Physical Therapist Assistant (PTA)

- TEAS entrance exam, minimum score 65% (3 lifetime attempts in person)
- B- or higher in the following courses:
 - BIOSCI-177 or BIOSCI-201 and BIOSCI-202
- Spring start: Review window in September (only one time a year)



Associate Degree Programs (continued)

Radiography (RadT)

- TEAS entrance exam, minimum score 70%, 70% in Math, 70% in Science (3 lifetime attempts in person)
- B- or higher in the following courses:
 - BIOSCI-177 or BIOSCI-201 and BIOSCI-202
- Fall start: Review window in February (only one time a year)

Registered Nursing (RN)

- TEAS entrance exam, minimum score 65% (3 lifetime attempts in person)
- B- or higher in the following courses:
 - BIOSCI-177 and 179 or BIOSCI-201 and BIOSCI-202
 - BIOSCI-197 (Sciences must be taken within last five years)
- Nursing Assistant training
- Fall start: Review window in February
- Spring start: Review window in September

Respiratory Therapy (RT)

- TEAS entrance exam, minimum score 60% (3 lifetime attempts in person)
- B- or higher in the following courses:
 - BIOSCI-177 or BIOSCI-201 and BIOSCI-202
- Fall start: Review window in February (only one time a year)

Surgical Technology (ST)

- TEAS entrance exam, minimum score 60% (3 lifetime attempts in person)
- C+ or higher in the following courses:
 - BIOSCI-177 or BIOSCI-201 and BIOSCI-202
 - HEALTH-101 with grade of C or higher
- Fall start: Review window in February
- Spring start: Review window in September

Certificate Programs

EKG Technician Certificate

- Cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher
- BIOSCI-177 C+ or higher
- Fall start: Review window in February
- Spring start: Review window in September



Technical Diploma Programs

Minimum cumulative grade-point average required is 2.0 unless noted otherwise.

Dental Assistant

- No prerequisite courses
- Fall start: Review window in February
- Spring start: Review window in September

Health Unit Coordinator

- C+ or higher in the following courses:
 - HEALTH-101
 - HEALTH-104
 - HEALTH-107
- · Fall start: Review window in February
- Spring start: Review window in September

Medical Assistant (MA)

- C or higher in the following courses:
 - ENG-195 or ENG-201
 - HEALTH-101
 - HEALTH-107
- · Fall start: Review window in February
- · Spring start: Review window in September

Medical Coding Specialist

- C or higher in the following courses:
 - BIOSCI-189 or BIOSCI-177 or BIOSCI-201 and BIOSCI-202
 - HEALTH-101 and HEALTH-107
- Fall start: Review window in February
- Spring start: Review window in September

Medical Interpreter

- Successfully complete an oral and written language assessment. Please contact Program Chair Rodney Ramos, ramosre@matc.edu, directly to set up a time to take the assessment.
- **Fall start:** Review window in **February** (only one time a year)

Phlebotomy

- No prerequisite courses
- · Fall start: Review window in February
- Spring start: Review window in September

Practical Nursing (PN)

- TEAS entrance exam, minimum score 58.7% (3 lifetime attempts in person)
- Cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher
- · Nursing Assistant Training
- B- or higher in the following courses:
 - · BIOSCI-177 or BIOSCI-201 and 202 (Sciences must be taken within last five years)
- C or higher in General Education courses
- · Fall start: Review window in February
- Spring start: Review window in September
