Phlebotomy Program

1. Prerequisites

- 1 year of high school-level biology
- Criminal Background Check, Drug Test and Medical records required after acceptance

The Phlebotomy Program Petition **TWICE** a year: in **OCTOBER** for JANUARY start and in **MARCH** for AUGUST start.

The Petition Process is the method that students follow to inform the Healthcare Pathway when they are ready and prepared to begin the core technical courses in their chosen health science program. All students must petition and be accepted into their program before registering for core technical courses.
