2. Petition Requirements

Students who petition and have all prerequisite course work completed will have priority acceptance. Students who petition and are still in progress completing prerequisite course work will be considered for acceptance based on seat availability.

- Prerequisite courses (except science courses) with grades of C or higher.
- Science courses BIOSCI-177 (or BIOSCI-201 & BIOSCI-202) with grades of B- or higher.
- Cumulative GPA of 2.5
- Completion of an approved Nursing Assistant training program.
- Sciences must be taken within the last five years.
- Entrance Exam: PAX-NLN <http://www.matchealth.com>
 - Minimum score of 100
 - Scores expire and do not qualify after 5 years
 - 3 attempts within a 3 year window
