Credentialing Examination Pass Rate

Five-year average credentialing examination (American Registry of Radiologic Technologists Radiography exam) pass rate of not less than 75% on first attempt within six months of graduation. The figure reflects an average over a five-year span. The MATC 5-year average ARRT pass rate was 97% between 2015 and 2019.

Job Placement Rate

Five-year job placement rate of not less than 75 % within twelve months of graduation. This number reflects students who gained employment in the radiologic sciences within twelve months of graduation verses the number who graduate and are actively seeking employment. The figure reflects an average over a five-year span. The MATC 5-year average job placement was **100 %** between 2015 and 2019.

Five-year Program Completion Rate Average

The number of students beginning the program versus the number of students completing the program graduation requirements. It is possible for a student to transfer into the program or change cohorts, allowing more students to graduate than started the program. The 5-year average completion rate was **75%** between 2015 and 2019.

Program Completion Rate 2019
