The Registered Nursing Program **Petition is TWICE a year. Petition in FEBRUARY** for AUGUST admission. Petition in **SEPTEMBER** for JANUARY admission. Student who petition and have all prerequisite course work completed will have priority acceptance. Students who petition and are completing final prerequisites may be considered for admission, based on seat availability.

The Petition Process is the method that students follow to inform the Healthcare Pathway when they are ready and prepared to begin the core technical courses in their chosen health science program. All students must petition and be accepted into their program before registering for core technical courses.

If offered a seat into the clinical courses, students can start their core/technical/clinical courses the following semester.

Employers will expect graduates to have a plan for completing their Bachelor of Science in Nursing degree. Some BSN courses may be taken concurrently with the associate degree courses.

2. Petition Requirements

Completion of:

- **ALL General Education courses** with **C** or higher
- Cumulative GPA of **2.5** required
- **ALL SCIENCE Courses** with **B-** or higher: **BIOSCI-177 & BIOSCI-179** (OR NATSCI-201 & NATSCI-202), **BIOSCI-197**, and **CHEM-186**(OR CHEM-207 & CHEM-208)
- **Completion of a WI-** approved nursing assistant training program or proof of completion of an out-of-state training program by approval from Department Chair of Nursing.
- **Entrance Exam: PAX-NLN** (minimum score of 120) Cost: \$40(subject to change)
