2. Waitlist Academic Preparedness Requirements

- Prerequisite courses (except science courses) with grades of C or higher
- Science courses with B- or higher: BIOSCI-177 & BIOSCI-179 (or BIOSCI-201 & BIOSCI-202), BIOSCI-197
- Sciences must be taken within the last five years.
- Cumulative GPA of 2.5
- Completion of an approved Nursing Assistant training program.
- Entrance Exam: TEAS <http://www.matchealth.com>
 - Minimum score of 65%
 - Scores expire and do not qualify after 5 years
 - 3 lifetime attempts
 - NLN PAX scores will no longer be accepted.
