

EPROD-152: eProduction Techniques and Implementation

Course Description:

This course focuses on the principles of design and operation of video systems as incorporated in multimedia, interactive and web design. This includes understanding, choosing and operating appropriate video cameras, digital SLR's, lighting techniques, audio acquisition and non-linear editing. Students will produce and post-produce several productions of increasing complexity for multi-platform delivery as it pertains to eProduction.
