Students learn web development concepts as they apply to content management systems (CMS). Students will develop websites using a variety of open-source CMS tools such as WordPress and Joomla. The final project is a website that students will develop using an open-source CMS tool. Total Credits: 3.00

- 7. Develop a fully-functional website that includes database interaction through the chosen content management system tool.
