The following symbols have been approved by the contracting school districts and will be used in student grade reports and records:

Α -	EXCELLENT	Is	making	excellent	progress;	displays	unusual	interest,
		ori	ginality, a	and initiativ	e; does wo	rk of exce	llent quali	ty.

B - VERY GOOD - Is making very good progress; displays very good effort; does very good work promptly and neatly; has very good study habits.

C - GOOD - Is making good progress; makes a response on definitely assigned work; is developing satisfactory study habits.

D - FAIR - Needs to improve; can do better work with more effort; should improve study habits and daily work; should prepare required work with more thoroughness.

U - UNSATISFACTORY Failure; is making unsatisfactory progress; displays little effort to achieve; lacks interest; work is too poor to justify passing.

The determination as to whether credit will be granted to a student is made by contracting school districts.

- I. The High School Contract office will send a class list to the appropriate instructors approximately one week before the end of each quarter.
- 2. The instructors should indicate each student's total periods of attendance, achievement and conduct grade, and return the list to the High School Contract office.
